



GET YOUR COVID-19 BOOSTER!

- Who:** These booster shots are for people who have received both doses of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine. Johnson and Johnson does not yet have a booster.
- What:** The COVID Booster Shots are an extra dose of medicine to help your body fight COVID. If possible, it's best to get the same brand you have on your vaccine card (Pfizer or Moderna)*. If you can not find a matching dose, it's okay to get the other one.
- When:** You can receive a booster 8 months after the date of your second vaccine. Booster shots should be available around September 20th.
- Where:** Make an appointment for the booster shot at your local pharmacy, health department, or doctor's office.
- Why:** With time, the COVID-19 vaccine that you have received is not as strong. You need a booster shot to help your body continue to be healthy and not get sick from COVID-19.
