
Is your child 8-12? Do they have a diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder?



Participation involves 4 sessions, each lasting up to 2 hours:

- 1 virtual session with parent
- 1 virtual session with child
- 2 MRI sessions at the Maryland Neuroimaging Center (MNC)



- During the virtual session, your child will play games and watch some videos with a research assistant. The games involve activities such as hearing stories about characters and deciding what they would or should do next.
- During your visits to the MNC, your child will play games while lying inside an MRI scanner.
- You will be compensated monetarily for your time and after the MRI session, your child will also get to pick out a toy prize!
- All of our staff have been trained for ensuring coronavirus precautions are strictly upheld.
- You will be provided more information during the screening call.
