APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Prepare and scan ALL the following documents with the support of your school counselor:

- Student transcript;
- A copy of
 - Student GED Ready scores, **OR**
 - SAT or ACT scores;
- Essay;
- Letter of recommendation from high school teacher;
- Counselor or Principal Recommendation Form; and
- Signed Released of Information Form.

DECISIONS RELEASED MAY 2, 2022

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Students must be rising 10th, 11th or 12th graders with at least a 2.5 GPA and must attend a DC public or public charter school.
