IDEA ADVOCACY TRAINING

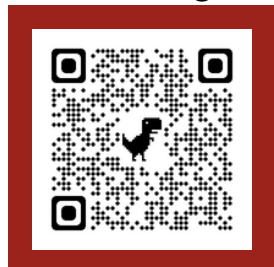
